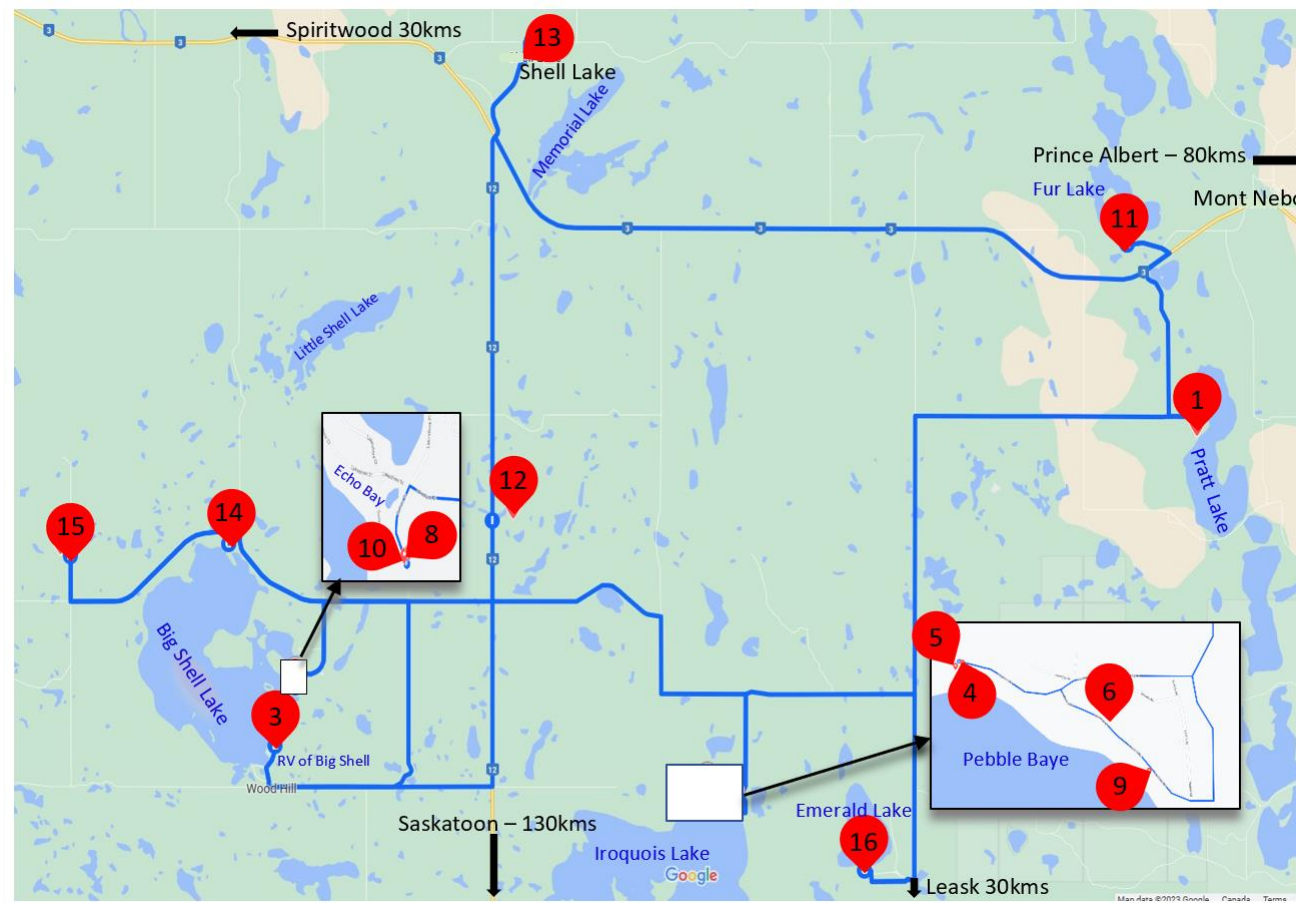


Welcome to Our World Class Trail!

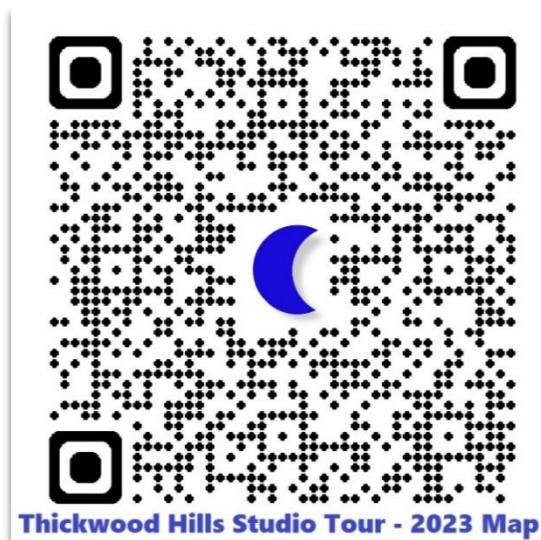

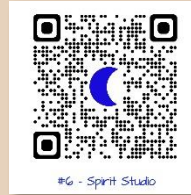
6. Spirit Studio - Theresa Fisher
